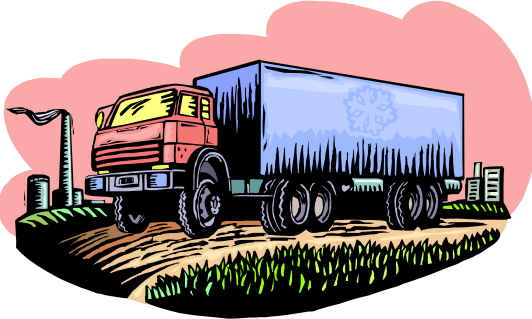




Local Government Heavy Vehicle Compliance
