Restrictions on Enrolment

Participants will not be enrolled in this course unless they are working in an animal control and regulatory environment or can demonstrate that they have access to a work environment that will allow them to complete all mandatory competency units. Proof of appropriate licences from relevant State or Territory authorities is required prior to enrolling in some competency units.

Enrolment and Induction

This may be carried out on-line or direct with Em-Four, or through their employer who contracts Em-Four.
