The Local Government Parking (Pre-Employment) Course has been designed as a pre-employment course for people who want to work as **Parking Patrol Officers** for **local councils** or similar organisations.

The course includes an introduction to the Australian Legal System, evidence gathering for parking offences, the use of notebooks and contemporaneous notes and occupational health and safety. It provides participants with a sound foundation on which they can develop their investigative skills for work in **local government**. Enrolment and Induction may be carried out on-line or direct with Em-Four.

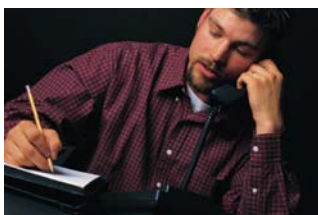
